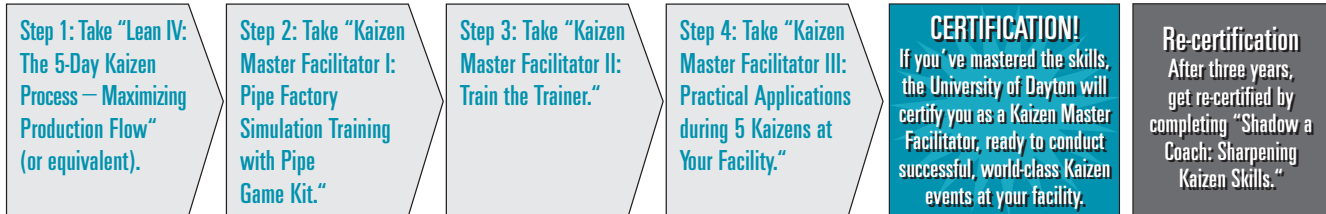

### Kaizen Master Facilitator I: Pipe Factory Simulation Training with Pipe Game Kit

Learn how to lead and facilitate a one-piece-flow simulation in your own plant.

#### What You Can Expect

Day 1 is a set of simulations that sharply contrasts the wastes and costs involved in batch processes with the speed and efficiency of one-piece flow (see "1-Day Kaizen: Pipe Factory Simulation"). On day 2, you'll learn how to lead pipe factory simulations in your plant, how to integrate a simulation into training you conduct during a Kaizen event, and facilitation skills. You'll get advanced training on using Kaizen forms, choosing projects, and ensuring a successful simulation event.

#### What You Can Expect

You'll learn the proven, four-step process for ensuring a successful Kaizen and discover how taking shortcuts produces mediocre results. Through role-playing, you'll respond to challenging situations that occur during Kaizen events. Get the training you need to steer your events back on track. (Bonus! Get *Kaizen: A Guide for Facilitators*, which includes facilitators' notes and teaching guidelines, technical modules for days one through five, overheads and other instructional aids, Kaizen forms, and checklists.)

Then select, plan, and run your own Kaizen event; afterward, submit a standard Kaizen report to UD for critique.
